Research Analysis

HB 3343 creates the Medical Uniform Durable Power of Attorney Act of 2022. The measure will apply to all powers of attorney for health and medical care decisions executed with the requirements of this act. HB 3343 specifies that all powers of attorney for health and medical decisions executed on or after November 1, 2021 but no later than the effective date of this act are valid and enforceable. The measure identifies permissible contents and scope of durable power of attorney and provides procedures for execution of durable power of attorney.

HB 3342 provides all other requirements and scenarios regarding durable power of attorney. The measure declares an emergency.
