**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS to HB 3366 calls for the funeral directors to fill the death certificates with either a driver's license or state identity number if available.

From the State Department of Health:

If we can collect the information and not display it on the death certificate, there is no fiscal impact. It can be collected and transmitted to Election Board with no problem and it can be done relatively quickly. This would be similar to all the medical information collected on a birth certificate, but doesn't display on the copy we issue.

If the bill's intent is that the drivers licenses needs to show on the face of the death certificate when printed, the cost will be high. The certificate format will have to be changed, multiple areas within the data system (ROVER) will need to be changed, etc. which will be expensive and take an extended time to accomplish.
