**Research Analysis**

HB 3367 extends the time period a person discharged from the military is eligible for in-state tuition at a state college or university.

Currently, a person who was discharged from the military within the past 5 years is eligible for in-state tuition. HB 3367 extends that to 10 years.

The measure also allows any member of the Armed Forces who was stationed in Oklahoma for more than one year at any time in the previous ten years to be eligible for in-state tuition.

These provisions also apply to the person's spouse and dependent.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This benefit is being provided currently for five years after discharge for veterans, their spouse, and dependents. It is not known how many of those eligible may participate in the program, but the changes provided in the measure are anticipated to result in an additional impact of \$1,500,000 to the higher education system.
