## **Research Analysis**

HB 3372 allows the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to create and promulgate rules and procedures for a program with the purpose of distributing state surplus vehicles to nonprofits that work to benefit formerly incarcerated persons. OMES is authorized to establish the criteria for qualifying surplus vehicles and the method for vehicle distribution. Former prisoner eligibility should be based on a screening process developed by the nonprofit organization involved.
