**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 3382 creates a maximum administrative penalty of \$5,000 per day for violating groundwater and stream-water use policies, such as permit conditions, the unauthorized use of water, unauthorized transfer of a water right, water waste, and disregarding unsafe water works. The measure also increases the maximum fine from \$250 to \$1,000 for persons found guilty of a misdemeanor offense for groundwater use violations.
