**Research Analysis**

HB3385, as introduced, allows a legal action to be filed against a limited liability company (LLC) in any county in which the LLC is situated, has its principal office or place or business or where any of the members, principal officers or codefendants of the LLC reside.

The venue rules proposed by the bill for LLCs mirror existing venue rules for legal actions against corporations.
