Research Analysis

HB3403 modifies the definition of "recycled water" to include oil and gas produced water and waste that has been treated by thermal, or any other commercially viable technological processes, into a reusable form.

The measure also modifies the definition of "treated constituents" to mean any byproduct removed from oil and gas produced water through a thermal treatment, or any other commercially viable technological process.
