Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB3425 adds that when a resident is in a private setting in a nursing home, skilled nursing home, or assisted living facility receiving personal services, there must be at least two individual in the room unless the resident requests to only have one person present. The PCS also outlines that failure to comply will considered to place the resident in immediate jeopardy as outlined in the Nursing Home Care Act.

HB3425 requires two individuals, or one if requested, in the room with a nursing home or skilled nursing home or assisted living facility resident while in a private setting receiving personal services. Violations may result in monetary penalties and loss of state certification.
