**Research Analysis**

The amendment to the proposed committee substitute for HB3425 adds "assisted living center" to the measure in addition to nursing home or skilled nursing home.

HB3425 requires two individuals, or one if requested, in the room with a nursing home or skilled nursing home or assisted living facility resident while in a private setting receiving personal services. Violations may result in monetary penalties and loss of state certification. Failure to comply will be considered to place the resident in immediate jeopardy as outlined in the Nursing Home Care Act.
