**Research Analysis**

HB 3426 allows a municipal court to contract with a statewide association of municipal governments to administer contracts with third parties attempting to locate and notify persons of their outstanding fines and fees. A person may make a payment to the contractor and may pay the fine in lieu of appearance before the court.

**Fiscal Analysis**
