**Research Analysis**

HB 3429 authorizes a county to submit a record of conviction for larceny of livestock to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for placement on the Livestock Offender Registry in lieu of sending a paper copy of the judgement and sentence.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3429, as introduced, allows courts the option to transmit an electronic record of conviction in lieu of a paper copy of the judgement and sentence to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to maintain their Livestock Offender Registry.

After review with the ODAFF and the Administrative Office of the Courts, passage of the measure will not require additional appropriations and may result in cost savings and efficiencies.
