Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 3430 requires swine exhibitors to provide a federal or state location identification number and an individual identification prior to brucellosis testing. The measure provides three testing options for exhibition swine; exhibitors must ensure their swine: 1. adhere to the testing schedule for fall and spring shows and meet documentation requirements;

2. in the case of out-of-state swine, meet provisions for out-of-state swine that are in <u>OAC 35:15-</u>22-33; or

3. originate from a validated-qualified herd and meet documentation requirements.
