## **Research Analysis**

FA1 to HB3469 allows a parent of a deceased child to view and to hold the child's body before the medical examiner assumes custody of the body. FA1 also prohibits a parent of a deceased child from viewing nor holding the child's body after a medical examiner assumes custody of the body unless the parent first obtains the consent of the district judge, medical examiner or person acting on behalf of the district judge or medical examiner. Lastly, the bill provides specific conditions for viewing or holding the body of a deceased child that is under investigation.
