**Research Analysis**

HB3470 adds the definition of "remote supports" to statute, which is defined as community service workers using technology to provide remote health-related services or supportive assistance to individuals with developmental or intellectual disabilities. The measure also extends the period for temporary employment before receiving background check results to 45 days. Additionally, the provider for a community services worker who will provide remote services from outside Oklahoma must provide an FBI Identity History Summary Check in lieu of a OSBI criminal history records check.
