HB3472 allows any preacher, minister, priest, rabbi, or ecclesiastical dignitary to submit a sworn affidavit to the office of the court clerk in the county where they intend to solemnize a marriage instead of filing a copy of their credentials. The sworn affidavit must list their credentials or authority authorizing them to solemnize a marriage.
