**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute (FA1) to HB 3497 modifies Section 1, subsection 37(h).

FA1 authorizes a pharmacist to test or screen for and treat minor, nonchronic health conditions and allows the pharmacist to use any test that may guide clinical decision making or any established screening procedures that can safely be performed. The measure also allows a pharmacist to dispense a self-administered hormonal contraceptive and nicotine replacement therapy products under protocol established in this act regardless of whether the patient has obtained a prescription.

FA1 requires the Board of Pharmacy to adopt regulations establishing a protocol for dispensing self-administered hormonal contraceptives and nicotine replacement therapy products. Lastly, the measure modifies the definition of "practice of pharmacy" and declares an emergency.
