**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute to HB 3512 adds, modifies, and deletes certain definitions in the measure. FA1 modifies a restriction to pharmacy benefits managers (PBMs) or an agent of a PBM. A provider contract is restricted from prohibiting or penalizing a pharmacy or pharmacist for disclosing to an individual any health care and cost information that the pharmacy or pharmacist deems appropriate.

FA1 modifies the requirements a health insurer is responsible for under the Patient's Right to Pharmacy Choice Act.
