Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute to HB3567 authorizes the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority (OCIA) to issue bonds to acquire property to construct improvements to and to provide funding for repairs of the system of tunnels underneath the State Capitol Office Complex. Total project costs should not exceed \$19 million and should be repaid with 25 years.

The measure also authorizes OCIA to barrow money on the credit of the income and revenues gained from leasing the property to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) and to capitalize on interest for up to one year. If OCIA does not capitalize interest and/or for subsequent fiscal years, the lease payments for the debt service will be paid from appropriations made to OMES by the Legislature. Upon final payment, the title of the property will be transferred from OCIA to OMES.
