HB3571, as introduced, authorizes up to \$70 million in bond issuance to fund the renovation, repair and remodeling of the Jim Thorpe Office Building.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure authorizes the Oklahoma Capitol improvement Authority (OCIA) to issue up to \$70,000,000 in lease revenue obligations to renovate the Jim Thorpe Building. Obligations may be issued n one or more series.

Lease payments on the obligations will depend on the structure of the issuance and the market conditions at the time of issuance.

Other Considerations

For example, lease payments on a single series, \$70,000,000 issuance with a average coupon rate of 2.0% for 20 years would approach \$4.2 million.

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
