**Research Analysis**

HB 3642 raises the maximum fine or deferral fee a municipality can impose for offenses other than traffic, alcohol or drug related offenses from \$750 to \$1,000. It also raises the maximum amount a municipality can charge for court costs from \$30 to \$50.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure increases the maximum fine or deferral fee for all offenses not specifically listed from seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). The court cost limit is increased from thirty dollars (\$30.00) to fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Any revenue resulting from the increased maximum amounts will depend on the application of the maximum amounts.
