## **Research Analysis**

The CS to HB 3648 creates Mackenzie's Law. The measure provides that a preliminary hearing be commenced no later than nine months from the initial appearance of the defendant. If commencement of the preliminary hearing is delayed past the nine month time limit, a show cause hearing is to be scheduled by the court.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to the measure would amend criminal procedure by requiring a show cause hearing to be conducted when a preliminary hearing is not set within nine months of the initial appearance of a defendant.
