Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3648 creates Mackenzie's Law. The measure provides that a preliminary hearing be commenced no later than eighteen months after the arrest or personal appearance of the defendant. If commencement of the preliminary hearing is delayed past the eighteen month time limit, a show cause hearing is to be scheduled by the court.
