Research Analysis

The floor substitute for HB3691 allows contracts for alternative energy production infrastructure to qualify as "performance-based efficiency contracts" and allows alternative energy production infrastructure to qualify as an "energy conservation measure". The Office of Management and Enterprise Services is authorized to determine who is a "qualified provider".

The measure also allows state agencies to enter into performance based efficiency contracts on behalf of themselves.
