Research Analysis

HB3720 requires Holocaust education to be taught in all public schools in a manner that:

- Generates an understanding of the causes, course, and effects of the Holocaust;
- Develops dialogue with students on the ramifications of bullying, bigotry, stereotyping, and discrimination, and
- Encourages tolerance of diversity

The measure requires the State Board of Education to work in consultation with experts to develop and distribute curricula for students in grades 6-12.
