Research Analysis

HB 3767 allows any authorized agent of any political subdivision's transportation agency is authorized to cause to be towed any vehicle found upon public roads, highways, streets, turnpikes, private parking lots accessible to the public, other public places or upon any private road, street, alley or lane which provides access to one or more single-family or multifamily dwellings under certain conditions. The measure allows for the removal of unattended vehicles which constitutes a hazard or obstruction to the normal movement of vehicular, public transit or pedestrian traffic. An unattended vehicle shall be deemed to constitute an obstruction if any portion of the vehicle remains in that lane of traffic designated by traffic lane markings or if any portion of the vehicle is outside of the designated parking location and protrudes into the lane of traffic.
