Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3848 requires certain information to be collected by entities engaged in the criminal justice system. All municipal police departments, county sheriffs, jail and county detention centers, district court clerks, district attorneys, and public defenders offices are required to collect information on detainees and persons involved in the criminal justice system. The collected information is to be published by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in an open electronic sortable format. Agencies with more than 500 employees are to submit data to OMES by July 1, 2023. Agencies with more than 100, but less than 500 employees are to submit data by December 31, 2023. Agencies with less than 100 employees are to submit data by July 1, 2024. The measure allows any member of any board of county commissioners to bring an action in district court if OMES determines that an agency is in noncompliance with the requirements outlined in the measure.
