Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 3856 creates the Task Force for the Study of Theft and Delivery and Consequential Youth Access of Alcohol Across Oklahoma. The task force is directed to produce a written report and public policy and best practice recommendations regarding theft and delivery and consequential youth access of alcohol in Oklahoma. The task force will consist of 14 members selected by the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission, with the chair and vice-chair being appointed by the Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, respectively. The task force sunsets on January 1, 2023.
