**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3891 prohibits medical marijuana commercial grow operations and processors from being within 1,000 feet of any public school. *Public school* is defined as any free school supported by public taxation, including property used for athletic events, and excludes private schools, home schools, and virtual schools. Grow operations established within 1,000 feet from a school at the time of initial licensure are exempt from these provisions, as are grow operations already licensed when a new public school is established within 1,000 feet.
