**Research Analysis**

HB 3918 directs that when a commutation is granted, the Governor is to file notice with the clerk of the court which imposed the original sentence within 30 days and requires the Governor to provide certain information in the notice. The Governor is to ensure that all victims are given notice in writing of the decision no later than 20 days after commutation has been granted or denied.
