**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute for HB3968 allows students who transfer districts during summer break to play sports the first year at their new district instead of waiting a year to be eligible. Transfer students who are dependents of active uniformed military personnel are also exempt from the one-year waiting period. If the student transfers during the year and qualifies for a hardship waiver, their eligibility to play sports will be determined by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association.
