Research Analysis

HB 3996 provides that a 100% disabled veteran is not to be charged a fee for a replacement of a REAL ID Compliant or Non-Compliant Identification Card. The measure requires driver education instructor applicants to submit to an electronic criminal history record check. The measure creates a new endorsement category for motorcycle operators. A motorcycle with two wheels in contact with the ground and a motorcycle with three wheels in contact with the ground is an "L" endorsement. Motorcycles with only two wheels in contact with the ground is an "L2" endorsement. Motorcycles with three wheels in contact with the ground is an "L3" endorsement.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure, as introduced, would amend sections of law relating to driver licensing duties of the Department of Public Safety. The measure would eliminate the fee for replacement identification cards for 100% disabled veterans. The measure would require that driver education instructors submit to an electronic criminal record check. The measure would also establish a separate license endorsement for three-wheeled and two-wheeled motorcycles, as well as a combination endorsement.

Upon review, and with consultation from the Department, passage of the measure would have a minimal fiscal impact. The impact is estimated to be absorbable within existing budget resources.
