## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure, as introduced, would amend the statutory definition of "obscene material" to include written matter and drawings.

Upon review, the measure may have a fiscal impact. By expanding the definition of "obscene material", the measure may increase the number of criminal convictions. The potential increase in incarceration costs may be offset by fine revenue from assessed penalties.
