## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 4082, relating to law enforcement responsibility for transporting persons for mental health services, specifies if transportation is needed within the thirty-mile radius, the law enforcement agency that made the initial contact within its jurisdiction is required to transport the individual inside the thirty-mile radius.

The CS clarifies that transportation requirements are considered completed once a connection has been made with staff of the health care facility and its apparent the patient is not a harm to themself or others.

The CS eliminates the exclusion in the definition of "initial contact" in the bill.
