**Research Analysis**

HB 4143 the subcommittee recommendation, creates a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security to be designated the Oklahoma Task Force 1 Urban Search and Rescue Out of State Deployment Revolving Fund. The fund will be a continuing fund and should be expended for the reimbursement of participating agencies with the Oklahoma Task Force 1 Urban Search and Rescue as is consistent with the federal Emergency Management Assistance Compact Guidelines.
