Fiscal Analysis

The measure includes an appropriation to the Department of Commerce of three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000) to implement a program of reparations for damages to persons and property during the events of approximately May 31 through June 1, 1921, in the City of Tulsa known as the "Tulsa Race Massacre". The Department, with assistance, is charged with creating and administering a program where survivors and descendants of victims of the Tulsa Race Massacre may apply for and receive payments from a newly created Tulsa Race Massacre Victims' Compensation Revolving Fund. Estimates as to any necessary administrative costs for the program are being evaluated.
