The floor substitute for HB 4192 requires agency directors to have their agency website in compliance with all personally identifiable data laws found in <u>Title 74 Section 3106.4</u> within 12 months of November 1, 2022. It also gives agencies 12 months to comply with any new rules or statutes to the personally identifiable data laws found in <u>Title 74 Section 3106.4</u>. The noncompliance of agency websites will result in the removal of the agencies director who may only return if reappointed.
