**Research Analysis**

The floor substitute for HB4195 allows students in 9th and 10 grade to receive tuition waivers for a maximum of 6 credits of concurrent enrollment courses per year, subject to the 11th and 12th grade concurrent enrollment program being fully funded.

**Fiscal Analysis**

While the measure is still under review, it is subject to the availability of funds. The state currently does not fully fund concurrent enrollment for junior, however available funding does allow the OSRHE to fund approximately 11% of eligible juniors. As such, OSRHE is requesting an additional \$4 million for FY 23 to fully fund juniors in addition to the \$11,764,823 appropriated in FY 22 to the Regents for the concurrent enrollment program.
