Research Analysis

HB4196 creates the "Needed Oklahoma Workers Act" and establishes a revolving fund to consist of state appropriations for the State Regents to carry out the provisions in the Act. The Regents are to distribute one-third of the funds to colleges and universities for nursing students, one-third for engineering students, and one-third for students pursuing a teaching degree. The money shall be divided amongst state colleges and universities on a per-student basis. The measure directs the Regents to implement the policies and procedures for the administration of the act.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure establishes the Needed Oklahoma Workers Fund within the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education consisting of state appropriated funds. Of the funds appropriated, one-third will be divided among institutions for enrolled nursing students, one-third for enrolled engineering students, and one-third for enrolled teaching students.
