The Senate amendment to HB 4281 amends the section of law related to cyanide coyote "getters" by removing a requirement for signage at the corners of perimeter fences that would notify others that devices equipped with lethal gas are in use.

The engrossed HB 4281 allowed hunters to use spotlighting and night vision when hunting coyotes.
