**Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute for HB 4287 creates the Oklahoma Flower Pre-Packaging Act, which requires all medical marijuana flower-based product sold by processors and growers to dispensaries to be in pre-packaged sizes of not less than one-half of a gram to not more than 3 ounces. The CCS allows non-opaque materials to be used when packaging flower so long as all other packaging and labeling requirements are met and it is placed in an opaque container before leaving the dispensary. The measure also allows the display and smelling of medical marijuana pursuant to current law.
