The committee substitute for HB 4288 requires labels on perishable medical marijuana products to include a maximum six-month expiration or use-by date if the product has not undergone stability testing. The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority is directed to promulgate rules establishing stability testing standards and requirements by November 1, 2022.
