Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 4352 exempts certain inmates from the requirement to complete resumes or practice job interviews prior to release from incarceration. These inmates include those 65 years of age or older; inmates released to medical parole; inmates released from the mental health unit; inmates released to another jurisdiction; inmates returning to community supervision from an intermediate revocation facility; and inmates that the Department determines would be physically or mentally unable to return to the workforce.

Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to the measure would exempt certain inmates in the custody of the Department of Corrections from certain mandatory pre-release employment readiness programs.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure would decrease the duties of the DOC regarding certain inmates, and so no additional appropriations would be needed to implement the provisions of the measure.
