**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 4352 exempts certain inmates from the requirement to complete resumes or practice job interviews prior to release from incarceration. These inmates include those 65 years of age or older; inmates released to medical parole; inmates released from the mental health unit; inmates released to another jurisdiction; inmates returning to community supervision from an intermediate revocation facility; and inmates that the Department determines would be physically or mentally unable to return to the workforce.
