Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to the measure would require the Department of Public Safety to accept a certified copy of a birth certificate in tandem with a Department of Corrections consolidated record card for the purpose of issuing a REAL ID Noncompliant Identification Card to inmates upon their release from custody.

Upon review, no direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated from passage of the measure. The measure would modify existing processes and does not create additional duties.
