Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB4357 creates the "Provisional License for Ex-Offenders Act," which states that, unless the applicant has been convicted of an offense specified in the bill, an occupational licensing authority must issue to an otherwise qualified applicant who has been convicted of an offense either the license they applied for or a provisional license, in which the rules for the provisional license and licensee are outlined in the measure. Nothing in the measure will be construed to require an employer or consumer to work with an unlicensed or not state certified individual, preempt federal regulation, or require a private certification organization to grant or deny private certification to any individual.
