**Fiscal Analysis**

The subcommittee recommendation would provide a 35% pay increase to each commissioned officer of the Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety, effective July 1st, 2022.

Upon review, and with consultation from the Department, passage of the measure would have an impact of approximately \$16,579,116 for FY-2023 and beyond. These costs would require additional appropriations to absorb.
