**Research Analysis**

HB4389 makes updates to computer science course requirements. The courses must, at a minimum, address Level I standards as defined in the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Computer Science and be approved for college admission requirements. The courses cannot focus their instruction on graphics, word processing and presentations.

The measure also requires the State Department of Education to include in its annual report on computer science, information about:

- How computer science courses are being delivered
- Qualifications of computer science teachers
- Demographics of students taking computer science
