**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 4395 directs the Department of Corrections to establish the Oklahoma Prisoner Reentry Pilot Program for inmates who have been sentenced to a term of imprisonment and are likely to benefit from a case management reentry strategy designed for the specific needs of an inmate who is transitioning from prison into the community.
