## **Research Analysis**

The PCS to HB 4406 requires hospitals and licensed birth centers to make a reasonable and good faith effort to report all deaths that occur during pregnancy or within one year of termination of pregnancy to the local coroner or medical examiner for consideration of an autopsy.

The PCS requires these deaths to be reported within seventy-two hours after the death occurs. Medical examiners are then required to conduct a death investigation with autopsy strongly recommended by not required.
