**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 4459 in its current form increases from \$120,000,000 to \$150,000,000 the annual allocation cap to the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges (CIRB) Fund. The increase is phased in over a six-year period, with increases to the cap of \$5,000,000 per year until the \$150,000,000 cap is reached for FY-28 and subsequent years.

The measure results in annual increases of \$5,000,000 to CIRB over each of the next six fiscal years, with corresponding decreases to the State's General Revenue Fund Collections.
